This will be a comprehensive eight-hour course of instruction given in English covering agricultural labor and employment laws. **The course has been approved by the Labor Commissioner as satisfying the eight-hour continuing education requirement that farm labor contractors must complete within their individual licensing period as a condition to being issued their renewal.**

This course will also help farm labor contractors who now need to score 85% to pass their written exam. Although primarily designed for farm labor contractors, growers and other agricultural employers and human resource representatives may attend and will benefit.

The materials will be presented by Richard Quandt and cover the following topics: Wage and Hour; Child Labor; Payment of Wages; Cal-OSHA Safety Standards; Worker Protection Standards; Field Sanitation; Migrant and Seasonal Agricultural Worker Protection Act; State of California Licensing Requirements; Transportation and Housing; Insurance; Immigration Requirements; Agricultural Labor Relations Act; Prohibited Discrimination in Employment; Sexual Harassment; Family and Medical Leave.

The **license holder** must attend to satisfy the continuing education requirement. All **license holder participants** will be given a certificate of completion. A copy will be sent to the State Licensing and Registration Unit.
